A fully integrated enrichment program focusing on six areas of the Arts: Theater, Media Arts, Visual Arts, Dance, Music, and Writing/Poetry. Connecting students and artists from the NH State Council's Artists Roster, The League of NH Craftsmen, and from the four corners of the world. The program has succeeded in far exceeding its initial benefit as a class bringing programs to the entire school and broader community as well as sponsoring dozens of field trips to arts events. "Teachers across the disciplines see a greater need for Arts activities to stimulate learning in their classes. They are excited to stimulate learning by bringing the arts into their curriculum. Teachers do not work in a vacuum and learning does not just take place in the formal classroom. In order to continue to raise the bar and meet goals, teachers need the continued investment of their students. They must be excited about learning. With Experiencing the Arts we have seen firsthand that student learning is energized by enrichment experiences.
